No stamp duty

No council rates

Frequently Asked Questions

What does a Hometown Australia community offer?

We offer you independent retirement living with security, peace of mind, a range of amenities, and the company of other like-minded residents.

Is there on-site management?

Yes, you can relax in knowing communities have management available during set business hours and via appointment. In case of an emergency, there is also an after hours emergency call service to a Hometown Australia representative. Each community varies differently, speak with our sales representative to learn more about the community you are interested in.

Are there exit or deferred management fees?

There are no exit or deferred management fees at Hometown Australia.

Do I retain all capital gains when I sell my home?

Yes, any capital gains achieved are yours to keep!

Are there any legal costs or stamp duty payable when I purchase?

No, there are no government charges such as stamp duty.

Do government subsidies apply?

Yes, they certainly do. If you're eligible for a pension, rental assistance is paid on your site fees or payments through Centrelink or Veteran's Affairs. It is important to make your own inquiry as each individuals' circumstances and eligibility are different. To learn more, visit the Centrelink website.

Frequently Asked Questions

Are there any body corporate fees?

No, there are no body corporate fees. We have on-site managers who look after operations within the communities and the maintenance of the amenities.

Are there any other fees?

In addition to site fees you are responsible to pay for your own electricity, WiFi/NBN, and general household running. You are also responsible for the insurance on your own home if you wish to have home insurance.

How secure is my tenure?

The tenure is secured by a site agreement which is similar to a lease. Each state is governed by different legislation, so site agreements may vary from state to state.

Are the homes covered by builder's warranties?

Yes, there is generally a six-year structural warranty on all new home orders including a three-month maintenance period. If you purchase a pre-loved or display home in an existing community the remaining warranties are transferred to you. For any older homes we recommend you undertake a pest and building inspection in the same way you would if you purchased a home outside a community.

Do I need to maintain the gardens and lawn?

The community management maintains all the communal areas (please note: this may vary by community), however you are responsible for maintaining your own garden. Homes are designed to have low maintenance gardens to assist in the ease of over 50s living.

Can my family or friends stay with me?

Yes, your guests can stay, and they are welcome to enjoy the community amenities and activities with you! As a security measure, we do ask that you please advise management of any extended stay by visitors. Children are also welcome, but they do need to be supervised whilst in the community.

What happens when I want to sell my home?

You can sell the home yourself, list it with a real estate agent, or we can sell it on your behalf – the choice is yours.

Can I bequeath my home?

Yes, the home becomes a part of your estate. Your beneficiaries can reside in the community if they meet the criteria, or they may simply sell the home.

Are singles welcome?

Yes, most definitely! Our single residents blossom when they are welcomed into the community, quickly making new friends and taking up new interests.

Can I bring my own pet?

We believe that pets are a very valuable source of joy and companionship. Most of our communities are pet friendly, however there are some rules about the type of pets you can have, depending on the individual community. We encourage you to check with the community you're interested in.
