
**YOUNG CANADIANS DANCE AUDITIONS
2026-2027 SEASON**

Process

All individuals auditioning to become a singer with the Young Canadians must submit a headshot, a video introduction, vocal video as well as attend an in-person dance audition.

Stage 1: Video Vocal Audition, Introduction video and Headshot Submission

- Deadline for submissions is **Wednesday, June 11**

Stage 2: Attend in-person audition for dance/movement

- **Saturday, June 13**

Stage 3: Selected individuals will be asked to participate in a callback audition on **July 15 and 16**

Vocal Audition (Video), Introduction and Headshot

Rather than a single long video, we would like two separate clips: Introduction and Vocal. It's easier for us to review and easier for you to shoot.

Part 1: Introduction

- Name
- Where you are from
- Previous singing experience
- Why you would like to be a Young Canadian

Part 2: Vocal Audition

- Prepare a short solo in the musical theatre or pop genre
- Selection should be no longer than 1 minute and should highlight vocal range, tone and technique

Vocal Audition Tips

- Be relaxed and show your personality
- Wear close-fitting clothes to allow the panel to see full body movement, no sweats or baggy clothing
- Hair should be tied back, and jewelry should be removed

Video Submission Tips

For best results, place your recording device on a stationary object, such as a tripod or table. Do not tape a close-up; have your entire body (from head to toe) in the frame. Prior to recording, test that you are in focus and well lit, and that your video is free from distracting background noise.

- We will not be influenced by the professional quality of the video. Please do not worry about any elaborate lighting or studio conditions.
- Footage must be of clear viewing quality.
- Footage must be shot no more than six months prior to submission.
- Media-enhanced, highly edited, or promotional-type videos will not be reviewed.

- Audition: 7:00pm – 8:00pm

What is the registration process?

On the day of your audition please check in at the registration desk where you will be assigned your audition number.

Audition

Participants will be taught a dance combo or movement exercise in a group setting. Participants will be evaluated on technical ability, overall execution and performance capabilities for their age category.

We understand that not all singers/vocalists have taken prior dance classes.

What are we looking for?

We are looking for individuals who adapt well to new situations, learn quickly and are not afraid to step outside of their comfort zone. Remember to be yourself and to have fun. Treat it like a class. The audition is also a great opportunity for you to see if YC is a good fit for you.

What should I wear?

- Active or dancewear
- Dance shoes or runners
- Hair should be neatly styled and pulled up and off the face

Baggy clothing and hats are not permitted.

Where is the in-person audition location?

The Young Canadians Studio is located at the TransAlta Performing Arts Studios at Stampede Park, 1302 6 St SE.
