Speaker Pelosi and Leader Schumer,

We the undersigned organizations are writing to express our strong objection to the inclusion of Anti-Asian language in the CHIPS-Plus bill. Asian American communities are under attack, both from individual acts of hate and from federal government programs such as the China Initiative. We encourage Democratic lawmakers to strongly oppose any language that expands federal discriminatory policies targeting communities on the basis of race, ethnicity, national origin or religious background.

We understand that Sen. Rob Portman (R-OH) has proposed an amendment that would deny admission or revoke visas of Chinese nationals and others based on innuendo, bad information, and racial targeting. We also understand that this amendment includes language that would prevent the Department of Justice from dismantling the China Initiative. We strongly oppose the inclusion of this language in the CHIPS-Plus bill and we strongly encourage Democratic lawmakers to stand with AAPI and the broader civil rights communities in voting against the Portman amendment.

In addition, we encourage Democratic lawmakers to **reject any compromise legislative language** that would subject Asian American communities to heightened levels of government enforcement based on their racial and ethnic origin. These provisions are harmful to our communities and only increase our lived experiences of hate and violence.

Thank you for your consideration and your support of the AAPI community.
