MESSAGE FROM SUSAN LUDWIG, PRESIDENT

For more than 57 years, the Coast Guard Foundation has partnered with donors and the U.S. Coast Guard to tackle the toughest challenges confronting the men and women who protect our borders, support our economy, and work with allies to counter adversaries abroad. In 2025, that partnership delivered meaningful results and set the stage for even greater impact ahead.

The nation is asking more of the Coast Guard than ever before. In response, the service is investing in new ships, aircraft and advanced technologies while growing its force by 30%. That is 15,000 new members to meet the increasing demands placed on the service. The Coast Guard is counting on us to support these new members and the brave men and women already serving. We are answering that call.

More than halfway through our five-year strategic initiative to triple our annual support, we are on track to reach our goals. We have already secured over half of our \$98 million fundraising target, and the next two years are critical to achieving that goal.

In 2025, we invested more than \$1.4 million in 247 morale and wellness projects, awarded \$925,000 in scholarships to 255 Coast Guard children, and provided grants to 223 Coast Guard spouses pursuing higher education and professional certifications. We funded 58 resilience programs that reached 7,100 service members and family members. And when disasters struck, we were there, through flooding in Juneau and the Pacific Northwest and wildfires in California.

None of this happens without you. More than 19,500 donors stand behind Coast Guard members and their families every day, helping ensure they have support when they need it most. Since 1969, together we have provided more than \$122 million in support — and the need continues to grow.

Achieving our goals in 2026 and 2027 will allow us to deliver up to 700 scholarships, a seven-fold expansion of our Coastie Camper youth enrichment program, a four-fold increase in spouse education grants, and \$6.8 million in morale and wellness investment. The time is now.

Thank you for everything you do. Coast Guard members and their families know we stand behind them — and beside them — because of you.

EMERGENCY DISASTER RELIEF AND TRAGEDY ASSISTANCE

EMERGENCY DISASTER RELIEF: As natural disasters affected Coast Guard communities across the country in 2025, the Foundation provided \$40,000 in emergency relief to 17 Coast Guard members and their families whose homes were damaged or destroyed by flooding and wildfires, including a glacial dam burst in Juneau, Alaska, devastating flooding in the Pacific Northwest, and wildfires in California.

These grants helped cover the cost of insurance deductibles, temporary housing, home repairs, and replacing personal belongings and household goods, ensuring that Coast Guard families had the resources needed to recover and return to duty.

SUPPORT DURING TIMES OF CRISIS AND LOSS: The Coast Guard Foundation provided tragedy assistance to 21 families following the death of a Coast Guard member or immediate family member. Members who were critically injured or managing chronic illness also received financial support to aid in recovery, and long-term assistance continued for families of Fallen Heroes to honor their service and sacrifice.

Coast Guard Foundation support helped ensure that nine Coast Guard members could attend the memorial service for Reserve Chief Warrant Officer Michael Horan in January 2025. CWO Horan was killed in the line of duty as a Greensboro, North Carolina, police officer in December 2024. This support brought his shipmates together to honor his life and service, helping make the gathering possible during a difficult time.

MORALE AND WELLNESS

BUILDING MORALE AND WELLNESS: The morale and wellness of Coast Guard members is essential to readiness. The demands of service, long deployments, remote duty stations, and time away from loved ones can affect both physical and mental well-being. In 2025, the Foundation invested more than \$1.4 million in 247 national projects that supported health and wellness at Coast Guard units across the country. These efforts helped members remain mission ready while serving at sea and in remote locations and strengthened the community networks that sustain Coast Guard families.

Coast Guard Day celebrations, holiday gatherings, and unit-based activities helped reduce isolation and reinforce support networks. The Foundation also played a key role in celebrating service milestones. Partnerships with local commissioning committees helped bring the commissioning ceremonies of four new fast response cutters to fruition. Each cutter received a grant to establish a morale account and additional funding supported morale projects across the fast response cutter fleet.

CHAPLAIN-LED PROGRAMS: In partnership with the Coast Guard Chaplain's Office, the Foundation supported a nationwide effort to strengthen relationships and resilience across the service. In 2025, the Foundation funded 58 chaplain-led programs that reached more than 7,100 Coast Guard members and family members, creating meaningful moments of connection and reflection at units across the country. From suicide prevention training and marriage enrichment workshops to unit-based resilience experiences and spiritual fitness events, the programs met Coast Guard families where they serve and live and provided support during some of the most demanding moments of service. The program brought members and families from the Great Lakes region together for a day at Boundless Adventures in Wisconsin (below).



SECTOR NORTHERN NEW ENGLAND FALL FEST, PORTLAND, MAINE:

The Sector Northern New England Fall Fest (below) took place in Portland, Maine, during the 2025 government shutdown, a time of high stress and uncertainty about member pay that limited what families could spend on activities. With Coast Guard Foundation support, more than 100 Coast Guard members and family members participated in a fun, free event that brought joy and relief and gave everyone a meaningful morale boost.



STATION SOUTH PADRE ISLAND, TEXAS:

When Station South Padre Island experienced a fire in April 2025, the crew's recreation area was damaged by smoke and water. A grant from the Coast Guard Foundation allowed them to temporarily relocate their morale space and begin rebuilding a crew lounge where members could rest and recharge (below).

THE FACES OF OUR YOUTH ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS IN 2025 ►

The Foundation awarded more than \$416,000 in youth enrichment grants to 921 Coast Guard children in 2025, helping fund summer camps and access to technology for online learning and enrichment. These opportunities promoted confidence, skill-building, and social connection during the summer break, especially during times of transition or deployment. The Foundation's youth enrichment program, affectionately known as "Coastie Campers," has grown dramatically since it began, reflecting the growing reach and impact of our work for Coast Guard families.

EDUCATION PROGRAMS FOR COAST

Education remained a cornerstone of the Foundation’s work in 2025. A total of \$925,000 in scholarships was awarded to 255 Coast Guard dependent children, with individual awards ranging from \$2,500 to \$5,000. Funding supported students pursuing college degrees as well as technical and trade school pathways, reducing financial stress and allowing students to focus on their academic and career goals.

The Fallen Heroes Scholarship supports children of Coast Guard members who died in operational, line-of-duty service. This scholarship covers 100% of higher education expenses, including tuition and living costs, helping recipients graduate debt-free while honoring the sacrifice of their deceased parent. In 2025, seven children of fallen Coast Guard heroes received scholarships that covered 100% of their college and trade school costs, and eleven children overall received Fallen Heroes scholarships and booster grants.

The Foundation awarded grants of \$1,000 and \$2,000 to 223 Coast Guard spouses enrolling in college and professional certification classes. These investments strengthened household stability and expanded long-term career opportunities, critical support given the wage gaps military spouses face compared to civilian peers, along with the licensing hurdles and job searches that often accompany frequent relocations.

Workforce development programs provided classes and materials to 349 Coast Guard members earning captains’ licenses and professional credentials, supporting both mission readiness and transitions to civilian careers. An additional 133 grants helped members offset the cost of off-duty education.

At the U.S. Coast Guard Academy, the Foundation supported academic and athletic programs, waterfront activities and a fueling station for student-athletes. Through the generosity of a Coast Guard Foundation donor, a capable powerboat was donated to support cadet maritime training and sailing programs. The Foundation also supported Coast Guard K9 teams, funding care for working service dogs and specialized training for handlers while recognizing the operational importance of these teams and the unique bond they share.

BUILDING A STRONG COMMUNITY



HONORING COAST GUARD EXCELLENCE: We celebrated Coast Guard heroism and mission excellence at events across the country in 2025. Each event featured Coast Guard leadership, industry partnerships, and recognition of Coast Guard mission excellence in the region. U.S. Coast Guard aircrews from Air Station Corpus Christi and Air Station Houston were recognized at the Texas Salutes the U.S. Coast Guard dinner for their extraordinary response during the Kerr County flooding over the Fourth of July weekend.

A defining element of the response was the rescue operation at Camp Mystic, where rescue swimmer Scott Ruskan (above, left) and the crew of helicopter CG-6553 (above, right) played a pivotal role. Operating in extreme conditions, the crew directly rescued five campers from immediate danger and supported the evacuation of more than 200 survivors from the disaster zone. Ruskan's coordination on the ground was critical in directing incoming helicopters from multiple agencies, contributing to a record-setting Coast Guard single-mission rescue effort and underscoring the impact of seamless interagency cooperation during large-scale disaster response.

It's always a special opportunity when we can bring our scholarship recipients together with their benefactors. PROVIDING FULL MISSION SUPPORT: The Coast Guard's missions meet America's most diverse and dynamic security and economic needs — saving, protecting, and defending — at home and abroad. The Foundation's work is similarly dynamic. We target our financial and other



resources on the highest needs of Coast Guard members across our three broad mission areas. We use the term “full mission support” to define our flexible approach to assisting the Coast Guard — regularly assessing our programs and meeting frequently with Coast Guard leaders and members at all levels to identify the most pressing needs.

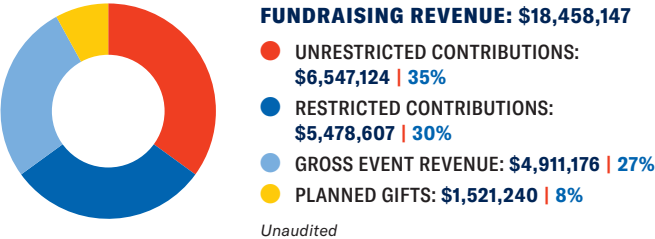

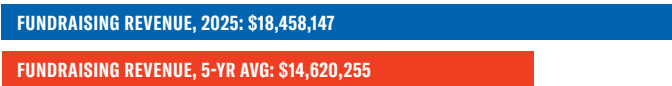

2025 FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS

WHERE DONATIONS CAME FROM ▶ The Foundation uses a diversified fundraising model that allows for long-term growth of our support to the Coast Guard while mitigating the risk from a decrease in any one area. Total revenue includes \$1,474,215 in unpaid pledges, deferred revenue, and revocable planned gifts.



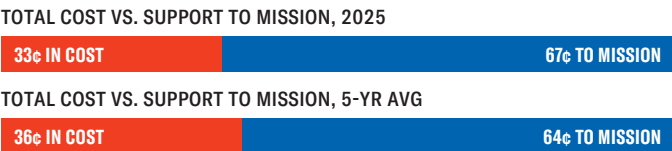
FUNDRAISING REVENUE, 2025 VS. 5-YEAR AVERAGE ▶



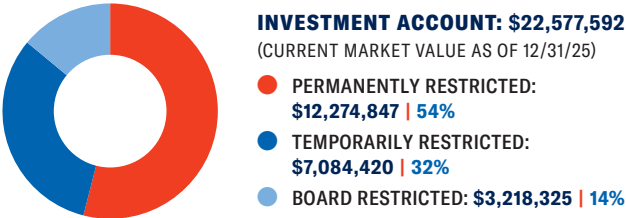
HOW FUNDS ARE UTILIZED ▶ On the support side, the Foundation’s financial assets provide direct grants to the Coast Guard. On the expense side, a proportion of funds used to provide program services are calculated as indirect support. In addition, the Foundation’s financial assets are utilized for fundraising expenses and to support the management and administration of our nonprofit organization.



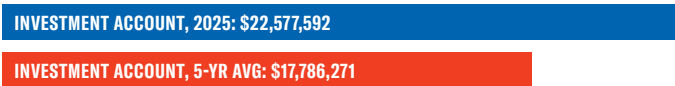
TOTAL COST TO RAISE \$1 VS. SUPPORT TO MISSION ▶



HOW WE PLAN FOR THE FUTURE ▶ An investment account consisting of endowed and non-endowed funds provide ongoing income for the Foundation’s mission and programs. Permanently restricted endowed funds provide usable income at a rate not to exceed 5% of the three-year average market value of the portfolio.

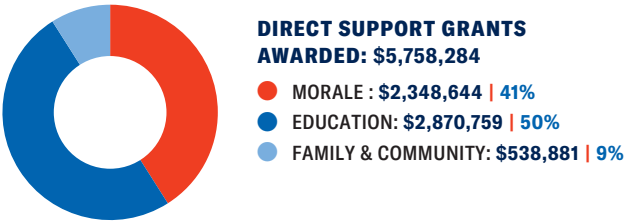


INVESTMENT ACCOUNT, 2025 VS. 5-YEAR AVERAGE ▶

PLANNING FOR THE FUTURE

We are in the middle of a five-year effort to strengthen and expand our support for the service and this next phase carries real importance. The progress made over the next two years will determine how far we can go in meeting the needs of Coast Guard members and their families going forward.

The Coast Guard is in a period of steady expansion and change. New assets are coming into service and the workforce is growing as thousands of new members join and train for demanding missions. That growth brings new pressures on people and families who make the mission possible every day. Our work is focused on staying ahead of that curve so support is in place where and when it is needed most.

WITH THE GENEROSITY OF OUR EXTRAORDINARY COMMUNITY, WE AIM TO PROVIDE:

- 700 Scholarships: to the children of Coast Guard members — doubling the number of children receiving scholarships from just five years ago while increasing each award to an impactful \$5,000.
- A 7X increase in our Coastie Camper program: awarding 2,600 Youth Enrichment grants to help Coast Guard children attend camp and enrichment activities, helping them learn new skills and meet friends in their new communities after a military transfer.
- A 4X increase in Spouse Education grants by 2027: helping nearly 1,400 Coast Guard spouses with their education and job skills in the next two years, all while doubling the value of these life-changing grants.
- \$6.8 million in morale and wellness projects: in the next two years — a 3X increase from only five years ago.
- Up to \$15 million in morale and wellness projects: at Coast Guard locations over the full initiative.
- An additional \$10 million in education grants and scholarships: more than doubling the number of Coast Guard members and family members we assist annually.

The board meets quarterly and sets the Foundation's direction and strategy; approves the annual budget; oversees the president; and ensures compliance with regulatory standards and reporting requirements. Board committees oversee the Foundation's finances, audits, investments, HR policies, and operations. Members of the board also act as ambassadors to Coast Guard units and donors nationwide, and provide significant financial support for the carrying out of the Foundation's mission.
